Tasting Notes – A perfect combination of California ripeness and the soul of the Northern Rhone are found in this Syrah. The wild blackberry and cassis fruit are laced with hints of smoked game, roasted herbs, vanilla bean and lavender.

Pair With – Leg of lamb! Nice and rare on the inside, crispy on the outside. Also works well with beef ribs, veal, venison, or even rabbit stew. Try duck raviolis in a crême sauce. Any strong cheese, such as Roquefort, pairs well. Drink now to 15+ years.
