Tasting Notes – The 2005 vintage genuinely highlights the roasted earth aspect of the Caldwell vineyard. Black, blue and red fruits intermingle with freshly ground espresso beans and a hint of springtime lavender and rosemary. The palate features raspberry and vanilla crème with gentle touches of roasted meat, black olives and white pepper.

Pair With – Leg of lamb! Nice and rare on the inside, crispy on the outside. Also works well with beef ribs, veal, venison, or even rabbit stew. Try duck raviolinis in a crème sauce. Any strong cheese, such as Roquefort, pairs well. Drink now to 15+ years.

“Caldwell Vineyard sits 500 feet above sea level giving panoramic views of Napa Valley, Mayacamas and Vaca Ranges. Grapes were first planted at the Caldwell site in 1982 with cuttings brought into the country using "creative" means. The weather at Caldwell Vineyards has a lot of similarities to its neighboring AVA, Carneros.” – Jeff Cohn
