Tasting Notes – Featuring concentrated aromatics of blackberry and cherry liquor with more subtle notes of ripe raspberry. Old world in nature, reflected in the smoked wild game, herbs de Provence and hints of bitter Swiss chocolate.

“The majority grapes in this wine continue to come from the Coombsville area of Napa Valley. This vineyard produces wines that show richness, depth and dark fruits. To highlight more of the mineral component we added Brousseau and Stagecoach Vineyard Syrah to the blend. A touch of Valdez Vineyard Petite Syrah brings additional layers of mystery and darkness.” – Jeff Cohn
