



## 2006 EAGLEPOINT RANCH PETITE SIRAH

100% Petite Sirah

**Tasting Notes** – Featuring aromas of blackberry liquor with subtle bright notes of blueberry that slowly fade into smoky crème brûlée. Smoky, hot tar mingles with freshly slit vanilla beans and warm blackberry pie. A firm backbone of tannin adds to the seemingly never-ending finish.

**Pair With** – This rustic wine craves rustic-style foods. Try pasta with a rich tomato based sauce or pizza with every crazy topping you can imagine. As the wine ages enjoy it with game meats and goat cheese. Also enjoyable with dried sausage, wild mushrooms, or lentils. When in doubt, a brontosaurus T-Bone steak works best. Drink now to 20 years.
