95% Syrah, 5% Petite Sirah

Tasting Notes – Loaded with aromas of blackberries, blueberries, black cherries, black licorice and chocolate. The palate demonstrates the levels that one can achieve when going in the right direction – pure, unadulterated black fruit and a cascade of spice, chocolate, and vanilla crème mixes with black licorice and subtle minerality.

Pair With – A country pate and a loaf of bread is a perfect companion. Or try lamb stew, smoked meats, or anything slowly simmered in a crock pot until the meat falls off the bone. This wine will handle spicy foods and pasta with rich red sauces as well.

*“The majority grapes in this wine continue to come from the Coombsville area of Napa Valley. This vineyard produces wines that show richness, depth and dark fruits. To highlight more of the mineral component we added Brousseau and Stagecoach Vineyard Syrah to the blend.
