100% Syrah

Tasting Notes – Elegance best describes this wine, gracefully showing off the softer side of Syrah. Rich in both aromatics and texture. Layered and incredibly long on the palate. A wine to contemplate, but also to enjoy in the moment.

Pair With – Wine with such a sweet mid-palate, it opens the door to many types of food pairings. Try turkey, but mostly dark meat in gravy with either a great chestnut or wild mushroom stuffing. Meats grilled on a Weber add just the right aroma of charcoal to dance with the smoky aspects of the wine. Also great with chilled rare roast beef, and pasta with lighter, more elegant red or crème sauces would fit the bill. Drink now to 5+ years.
