Tasting Notes – Aromas of incense and sweet pipe tobacco permeate the room, a touch of crushed white peppercorns and roasted sweet peppers. Flavors focus on blackberry and black cherry, with subtle hints of dates and figs. French vanilla bean accentuates a long finish.

Pair With – A true Bistro wine. Made for foods with garlic, cassoulet, duck, and pasta. Also great with grilled or roasted meats of all kinds. IF there is such a thing as a light paté, that would be great. Some stinky cheese would also work well, or a croque monsieur sandwich. Drink now to 5+ years.
