



2009 Iron Hill Vineyard Zinfandel

100% Zinfandel

Appellation: Sonoma

Tasting Notes: An amazingly deep rich color that leans toward black cherry red, when this wine is swirled it has better hang time than Michael Jordan! Aromatically this wine walks its own path. Starting with dark chocolate covered cherries, wild rosemary, loamy earth and raw meat that finishes with floral notes of lavender and a lightly spread raspberry jam on brioche. Plus (as the name implies) iron, laced with fresh vanilla bean, and a dash of cinnamon.

Pair With: Hearty stew, lamb, creamy goat cheese, pheasant, venison, beef casserole and a course a Valrhona dark chocolate bar.
