Tasting Notes: We added a new Grenache based blend of taking on the Misc. Stuff name. Minerality is the backbone of this wine it also carries the lush flavors of black raspberries, boysenberry and roasted nuts. Alongside black cherry, wild Herbs de Provence and freshly cracked black and red peppers on a sizzling rare rib eye steak served with a side order of pure decadence. Elegant and exotic and just a touch flamboyant. Sometimes that's all there is.

Pair With: Cassoulet, roasted leg of lamb, country pâté, roast duck, wild mushrooms, and just about anything that has truffles on it.
